- ⇒ The PASS was designed for parents to administer at home, greatly reducing the stress level of testing.
- ⇒ The PASS is untimed, which helps students to relax.
- ⇒ Students can test within the range of their abilities in each subject. On most achievement tests, where the difficulty of the items varies greatly, students are frequently presented with items that are either too easy or too hard, creating problems in assessing academic achievement.
- ⇒ Testing results show overall achievement as well as performance in each subject. The test is standardized and children's scores are compared with both national and home-schooling populations. This does not mean that the test is nationally normed, but that the scores are equated to those of public-school students taking one of the nationally-normed tests. Home-schooling parents will appreciate the suggestions given for reaching the goals in each of these areas.

What You Get

Books: If your student has never used the PASS or did not test within the last year, you will receive a set of books, one each for reading, language, and math and one with placement tests and instructions, along with the answer sheet and disposal form. In order to give families with more than one student a price break, we send only one set of books. Students can trade books in order to test at the same time.

SPECIFIC LEVELS: If your student tested one grade level lower within the last year, you will receive specific PASS Levels. We will determine the levels in each subject you need by looking at last year's test results and send the exact levels you need along with the answer sheet, disposal form, and instructions.

WHAT IS IT?

The PASS Test was developed specifically for home schoolers. New York, North Carolina, Georgia, Washington, and Alaska have approved the PASS for purposes of state reporting. In other states requiring testing, check with your local school district. Like other achievement tests, the PASS estimates student achievement in reading, math, and language.

TESTING SCHEDULE

While many parents test only once each school year, testing twice yearly is the most accurate measure of student learning. PASS Tests can be ordered at any time during the year, but must be at least six months apart. You have four weeks after receiving the testing materials in which to administer the test. Once testing materials are returned to Hewitt, expect to receive the detailed analysis within three to four weeks.

GROUP TESTING

Two or more families may order as a group, but be aware that:

- 1 Group tests are always shipped with books (no levels).
 - 2 We have to have parents' names and address for each child.
 - 3 They must be sent to one address, paid for with one check or credit card, and returned to us together.
 - 4 We have to have a physical street address for shipping.
 - 5 A group test returned separately to Hewitt for grading must include a \$10.00 fee.
 - 6 Test results are sent to the group leader.
- Large group tests take longer to process, so please order early.

RETURNING TESTING MATERIALS

You are required to return **ONLY** the answer sheet/s along with a signed form stating you have disposed of all testing materials. This is a **huge savings** compared with having to return the test books. We must have the declaration of disposal before processing test results.

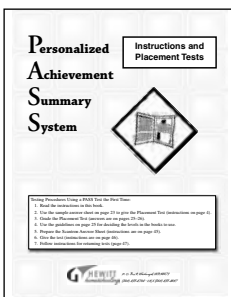

PASS GROUP LEADER INSTRUCTIONS

- Tests must be ordered from Hewitt at the same time and paid for with one check or credit card. Payment to Hewitt includes testing materials and shipping, scanning the answer sheets, and mailing the results to the group leader. It does not include the cost the group leader incurs in handling the testing material within the group or the return of the scan sheets and disposal forms to Hewitt.
- All testing material is sent to the group leader to disperse to the families in the group. Each family will have one scan sheet per student, a Disposal Verification form, and one set of books: Instructions, Reading, Language, and Math (if a family has students in both lower [Grades 3–5] and upper math [Grades 6–8], both books are included in the set).
- We ask that tests be returned within four weeks of their receipt by the group leader, who should let each family know when the tests are to be returned to her or him, so they can be returned to Hewitt on time.
- Families are to return their answer sheets and the signed Disposal Verification form to the group leader, who returns them altogether, each family's scan sheets collated with the signed disposal form, to Hewitt. We will not process any scan sheets without the signed form verifying the disposal of the books; be sure to include all of them, so the processing of your group order won't be delayed. If a parent decides against using the test, he or she should return the answer sheet to the group leader marked "cancel," along with the signed Disposal form (PASS tests are nonrefundable once they are printed).
- If a family cannot return its test/s in the time specified by the group leader, it should let the group leader know so the group isn't held up. A family can return the tests to Hewitt separately from the group, but will be charged an additional fee of \$10.
- Results are sent to the group leader to distribute to the individual families. Though there is a cover sheet over each family's tests, they are not packaged in separate envelopes.
